Dear Parent/Guardian,

Newmerella Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of Newmerella Primary School's Voluntary Financial Contributions for 2024.

Schools provide students with free instruction to fulfil the standard Victorian Curriculum obligations and we want to assure you that all contributions are voluntary. Nevertheless, the ongoing support of our families ensures that our school can offer the best possible education and support for our students. We want to thank you for all your support, whether that's through our request for financial contribution, fundraising or volunteering your time. This makes a huge difference to our school and the programs we can offer.

Within our school this support has allowed us to:

- Provide high quality programs and specialist class materials and equipment.
- Ensure the upkeep of our computer and IPAD devices to enhance learning opportunities.
- Maintain sufficient class sets of books for students to develop their reading skills.
- Facilitate Literacy and Mathematics online digital subscriptions.
- Deliver a range of materials to support our specialist subjects.

The total Curriculum Contribution for 2024 is \$285 per student (\$255 per student with a family pool pass).

Extra-Curricular Items & Activities

Payments for Extra-Curricular activities will be requested on an opt-in or user pays basis in 2024. Please find attached an outline of Extra-Curricular options the school is proposing for 2024. Can you please indicate on the form the camps you would be likely to purchase so we can plan for viability and final costs of running these activities.

Payment Methods

Cash or Cheques can be received at the school office
Direct Deposits - NAB BSB 083 001 Account 427881521
BPay - Contact the school office for BPAY codes
Centrepay deductions (centrelink) - Can be set up at the school office.

- An initial invitation for curriculum contributions will be sent 6 weeks prior to the commencement of the school year and requests will be sent out no more than once per term.
- All students have access to the standard Victorian Curriculum.
- Parents will be made aware of alternative payment options and an invitation to discuss these options on request to our office staff.
- Any record of payment or contributions by parents and guardians is to be kept confidential.





Refunds

Newmerella Primary school will consider requests for partial or full refunds of payments made by parents on a case-by-case basis taking into account the individual circumstances. Generally, we will not be able to refund payments made for costs that have already been paid where those funds have already been transferred to a third party. For example, camp costs when a child becomes unwell and cannot attend in circumstances where the payment has already been made or committed to a third party and no refund is available to the school.

Students Leaving Newmerella PS

If a student <u>transfers</u> to another Victorian school including Secondary, the unspent portion of the CSEF (for students who are eligible) will be forwarded to the student's new school so the student has access to the full value of the payment.

If a student <u>leaves</u> the Victorian school system, the CSEF receipt will remain with the school and may be used towards the expenses for siblings, or school incurred costs associated with operating camps, sports or excursion activities for students.

Credit amounts of parent payments (ie: Cash, Direct Deposit, Centrepay, BPay instalments) held at the time of the student leaving Newmerella Primary School will be refunded back to the parent.

ONE PAGE OVERVIEW



FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements in Victorian Curriculum F-10, VCE and VCAL.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.

PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:



Curriculum Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

• Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES

Schools must obtain school council approval for their parent payment arrangements and publish all requests and communications for each year level on their school website for transparency.
